
Good friday Reproaches

Sung at the Veneration of the Cross



- 1. O MY people, what have I done / unto thee? * or wherein have I / weared thee? Answer me!

- 3. Because I led thee through the desert forty years, and fed thee with manna, and brought thee into a land ex/ceeding good: * thou hast prepared a / Cross for thy Savior. *ANTIPHON I*
- 4. What more could I have done for thee that I have not done? I indeed did plant thee, my vineyard, ex/ceeding fair: * and thou art become very bitter unto me; for vinegar thou gavest to quench my thirst; and hast pierced with a spear the / side of thy Savior. *ANTIPHON I*
- 5. I did scourge Egypt with her first-born / for thy sake: * and thou hast scourged me / and delivered me up. *ANTIPHON II*
- 6. I led thee out of Egypt, drowning Pharaoh in / the Red Sea: * and thou hast delivered me / unto the chief priests. *ANTIPHON II*
- 7. I opened the / sea before thee: * and thou hast opened / my side with a spear. ANTIPHON II
