PSALM 59 Eripe me de inimicis

DELIVer me from mine ene/mies, O God; \* defend me from them that rise up a/gainst me.

- 2. O deliver me from the / wicked doers, \* and save me from the blood-thirs/ty men.

- 10. God showeth me his / goodness plenteously; \* and God shall let me see my desire upon mine en/emies.
- 11. Slay them not, lest my peo/ple forget it; \* but scatter them abroad among the people, and put them down, O Lord our / defense.
- 12. For the sin of their mouth, and for the words of their lips, they shall be / taken in their pride: \* and why? their talk is of cursing / and lies.
- 13. Consume them in thy wrath, consume them, that / they may perish; \* and know that it is God that ruleth in Jacob, and unto the ends of / the world.
- 14. And in the evening they / will return, \* grin like a dog, and will go about the / city.



- 15. They will run here and / there for meat, \* and grudge if they be not sa/tisfied.
- 16. As for me, I will sing of thy power, † and will praise thy mercy betimes / in the morning; \* for thou hast been my defense and refuge in the day of my / trouble.
