## Che fourteenth Day at Evening Prayer

PSALM 73 Quam bonus Israel!

Tone VII 7



TRULY God is loving / unto Israel: \* even unto such as are / of a clean heart.

- 2. Nevertheless my / feet were almost gone, \* my / treadings had well nigh slipt.
- 3. And why? I was grieved / at the wicked: \* I do also see the ungodly in / such prosperity.
- 4. For they are in no / peril of death; \* but are / lusty and strong.
- 5. They come in no mis/fortune like other folk; \* neither are they / plagued like other men.
- 6. And this is the cause that they are so / holden with pride, \* and cruelty covereth them / as a garment.
- 7. Their eyes / swell with fatness, \* and they do / even what they lust.
- 8. They corrupt other and speak of / wicked blasphemy; \* their talking is a/gainst the Most High.
- 9. For they stretch forth their mouth / unto the heaven, \* and their tongue / goeth through the world.
- 10. Therefore fall the / people unto them, \* and thereout suck they no / small advantage.
- 11. Tush say they, how should / God perceive it? \* is there knowledge / in the Most High?
- 12. Lo these are / the ungodly, \* these prosper in the world, and these have riches / in possession:
- 13. And I said, Then have I / cleansed my heart in vain, \* and washed my hands in / innocency.
- 14. All the day long have / I been punished, \* and chastened / ev'ry morning.
- 15. Yea and I had almost said / even as they; \* but lo, then I should have condemned the generation / of thy children.
- 16. Then thought I to / understand this; \* but it / was too hard for me,
- 17. Until I went into the sanctu/ary of God: \* then understood I the / end of these men;



- 18. Namely how thou dost set them in / slippery places, \* and casteth them / down and destroyest them.
- 19. O how sudden/ly do they consume, \* perish and / come to a fearful end!
- 20. Yea, even like as a dream when / one awaketh; \* so shalt thou make their image to vanish / out of the city.
- 21. / Thus my heart was grieved, \* and it went / even through my reins.
- 22. So foolish was / I and ignorant, \* even as it were a / beast before thee.
- 23. Nevertheless I am / alway by thee; \* for thou hast holden me / by my right hand.
- 24. Thou shalt guide me / with thy counsel, \* and after that re/ceive me with glory.
- 25. Whom have I in / heaven but thee? \* and there is none upon earth that I desire in com/parison of thee.
- 26. My flesh and / my heart faileth; \* but God is the strength of my heart, and my / portion for ever.
- 27. For lo, they that for/sake thee shall perish; \* thou hast destroyed all them that are un/faithful unto thee.
- 28. But it is good for me to hold me fast by God, to put my / trust in the Lord God, \* and to speak of all thy works in the gates of the / daughter of Sion.

Glory be to the / Father and to the Son, \* and / to the Holy Ghost; As it was in the beginning, † is now and / ever shall be, \* - / world without end. Amen.



O GOD, wherefore art thou absent from us so / long? \* why is thy wrath so hot against the sheep of / thy pasture?



- 2. O think upon thy congre/gation, \* whom thou hast purchased and / redeemed of old.
- 3. Think upon the tribe of thine in/heritance, \* and Mount Sion wherein / thou hast dwelt.
- 4. Lift up thy feet, that thou mayest utterly destroy every / enemy, \* which hath done evil in thy sanc/tuary.
- 5. Thine adversaries roar in the midst of thy congre/gations, \* and set up their banners / for tokens.
- 6. He that hewed timber afore out of the thick / trees, \* was known to bring it to an ex/cellent work.
- 7. But now they break down all the carved wood there/of \* with axes / and hammers.
- 8. They have set fire upon thy holy / places, \* and have defiled the dwellingplace of thy Name, even un/to the ground.
- 9. Yea they said in their hearts, Let us make havoc of them alto/gether: \* thus have they burnt up all the houses of God / in the land.
- 10. We see not our tokens; † there is not one prophet / more; \* no not one is there among us that understand/eth any more.
- 11. O God, how long shall the adversary do this dis/honour? \* shall the enemy blaspheme thy Name / for ever?
- 12. Why withdrawest thou thy / hand? \* why pluckest thou not thy right hand out of thy bosom to consume / the enemy?
- 13. For God is my King of / old; \* the help that is done upon earth he doeth / it himself.
- 14. Thou didst divide the sea through thy / power; \* thou brakest the heads of the dragons in / the waters.
- 15. Thou smotest the heads of leviathan in / pieces, \* and gavest him to be meat for the people of / the wilderness.
- 16. Thou broughtest out fountains and waters out of the hard / rocks; \* thou driedst up migh/ty waters.
- 17. The day is thine and the / night is thine; \* thou hast prepared the light / and the sun.
- 18. Thou hast set all the borders of the / earth; \* thou hast made summer / and winter.



- 19. Remember this O Lord, how the enemy hath re/buked; \* and how the foolish people hath blas/phemed thy Name.
- 20. O deliver not the soul of thy turtledove unto the multitude of the / enemies; \* and forget not the congregation of the poor / for ever.
- 21. Look upon the / covenant; \* for all the earth is full of darkness and cruel ha/bitations.
- 22. O let not the simple go away a/shamed; \* but let the poor and needy give praise un/to thy Name.
- 23. Arise O God, maintain thine own / cause; \* remember how the foolish man blasphemeth / thee daily.
- 24. Forget not the voice of thine / enemies: \* the presumption of them that hate thee increaseth e/ver more and more.

Glory be to the Father and to the / Son, \* and to / the Holy Ghost; As it was in the beginning, † is now and ever / shall be, \* world with/out end. Amen.
