PSALM 82 *Deus stetit*

Tone VIII 2



- GOD STANDeth in the congregation of / princes; \* he is a / Judge  
among gods.
2. How long will ye give wrong / judgment, \* and accept the persons  
of / the ungodly?
  3. Defend the poor and / fatherless; \* see that such as are in need and  
neces/sity have right.
  4. Deliver the outcast and / poor; \* save them from the hand of / the  
ungodly.
  5. They know not, neither do they understand, but walk on still in /  
darkness: \* all the foundations of the / earth are out of course.
  6. I have said, Ye are / gods, \* and ye are all the children of / the Most  
Highest.
  7. But ye shall die like / men, \* and fall like one / of the princes.
  8. Arise, O God, and judge thou the / earth; \* for thou shalt take all  
nations to / thine inheritance.

PSALM 83 *Deus, quis similis?*

- HOLD NOT thy tongue, O God, keep / not still silence: \* refrain / not  
thyself, O God.
2. For lo, thine enemies / make a murmuring; \* and they that hate thee  
have / lift up their head.
  3. They have imagined craftily a/gainst thy people, \* and taken  
counsel a/gainst thy secret ones.



4. They have said, Come, and let us root them out, that they be no / more a people, \* and that the name of Israel may be no more / in remembrance.
  5. For they have cast their heads to/gether with one consent, \* and are confeder/ate against thee:
  6. The tabernacles of the Edomites, / and the Ishmaelites; \* the Moabites, / and Hagarenes;
  7. Gebal, and Ammon, / and Amalek; \* the Philistines, with / them that dwell at Tyre.
  8. Assyria al/so is joined with them; \* they have holpen the / children of Lot.
  9. But do thou to them as un/to the Midianites; \* unto Sisera, and unto Jabin at the / brook of Kishon;
  10. Who / perished at Endor, \* and became as the / dung of the earth.
  11. Make them and their princes like / Oreb and Zeeb; \* yea, make all their princes like as Zebah / and Zalmunna;
  12. Who say, Let us / take to ourselves \* the houses of God / in possession.
  13. O my God, make them like un/to the whirling dust, \* and as the stubble / before the wind;
  14. Like as the fire that burneth / up the forest, \* and as the flame that consum/eth the mountains;
  15. Pursue them even so / with thy tempest, \* and make them a/fraid with thy storm.
  16. Make their / faces ashamed, O Lord, \* that they / may seek thy Name.
  17. Let them be confounded and vexed / ever more and more; \* let them be put to / shame, and perish.
  18. And they shall know that thou, whose Name / is Jehovah, \* art only the Most Highest / over all the earth.

  3. Yea, the sparrow hath found her an house, † and the swallow a nest, where / she may lay her young; \* even thy altars, O Lord of hosts, my / King and my God.
  4. Blessed are they that / dwell in thy house; \* they will be / always praising thee.
  5. Blessed is the man whose / strength is in thee; \* in whose / heart are thy ways.
  6. Who going through the vale of misery / use it for a well; \* and the pools are / filled with water.
  7. They will / go from strength to strength, \* and unto the God of gods appeareth every one of / them in Zion.
  8. O Lord God of / hosts, hear my prayer; \* hearken, O / God of Jacob.
  9. Behold, O / God our defender, \* and look upon the face of / thine anointed.
  10. For one / day in thy courts \* is better / than a thousand.
  11. I had rather be a door-keeper in the / house of my God, \* than to dwell in the tents / of ungodliness.
  12. For the Lord God is a / light and defense; \* the Lord will give grace and worship; and no good thing shall he withhold from them that / live a godly life.
  13. O / Lord God of hosts, \* blessed is the man that put/teth his trust in thee.

3. Thou hast taken away all / thy displeasure, \* and turned thyself from thy wrath/ful indignation.

5. Wilt thou be displeased at / us for ever? \* and wilt thou stretch out thy wrath from one genera/tion to another?

6. Wilt thou not turn a/gain, and quicken us, \* that thy peo/ple may rejoice in thee?

7. Show us thy mer/cy, O Lord, \* and grant / us thy salvation.

8. I will hearken what the Lord / God will say; \* for he shall speak peace unto his people, and to his saints, that they turn not a/gain unto foolishness.
