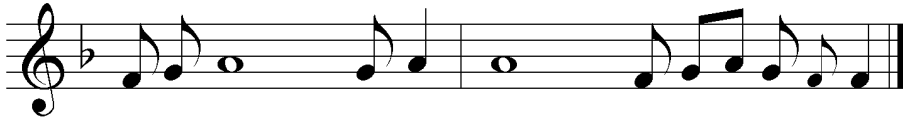


The Twenty-fourth Day at Evening Prayer

Tone VI A

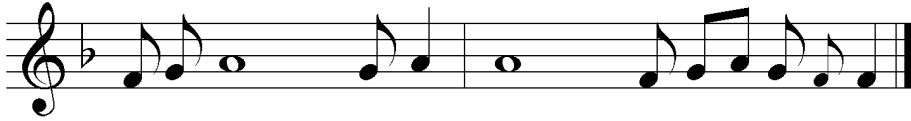


ALEPH *Beati immaculati*
