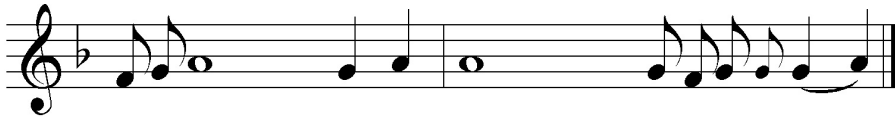


The Twenty—fifth Day at Morning Prayer

Tone I A 12

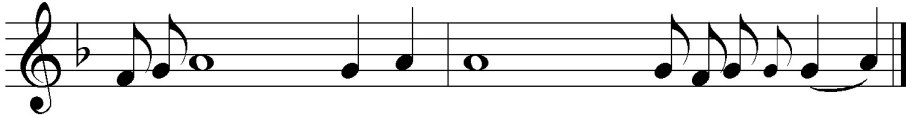


TEACH ME, O Lord, the way of thy / statutes, * and I shall keep it /
