- *13.* For he hath made fast the bars of thy / gates, * and hath blessed thy child/ren within thee.
- 14. He maketh peace in thy / borders, * and filleth thee / with the flour of wheat.
- *15.* He sendeth forth his commandment upon / earth, * and his word runneth / very swiftly.



- *16.* He giveth snow like / wool, * and scattereth the hoar-/frost like ashes.
- 17. He casteth forth his ice like / morsels; * who is able / to abide his frost?
- *18.* He sendeth out his word, and / melteth them: * he bloweth with his wind, / and the waters flow.
- 19. He showeth his word unto / Jacob, * his statutes and ordinances / unto Israel.
- 20. He hath not dealt so with any / nation; * neither have the heathen / knowledge of his laws.

- 8. Fire and hail, / snow and vapors, * wind and storm, ful/filling his word;

- 10. / Beasts and all cattle; * creeping / things and flying fowls;



- Kings of the / earth, and all peoples; * princes, and all / judges of the world;
- 12. Young men and maidens, old men and children, † praise the / name of the Lord: * for his Name only is excellent, and his praise above / heaven and earth.
- 13. He shall exalt the horn of his people: † all his / saints shall praise him; * even the children of Israel, even the / people that serveth him.
